On behalf of the Icebreaker 8K race committee, we want to sincerely thank you for your ongoing support and for being an important part of the KajaksTFC and Icebreaker family.

Out of an abundance of caution, we have made the difficult decision to postpone the 2022 Steveston Icebreaker 8K and New Balance 1K Kidsrun. With the rising case numbers and uncertainty of the Omicron variant, and after many discussions with our partners, we have decided it is in the best interest to move the Icebreaker and Kidsrun to April 10, 2022. At this time, our primary goal is public safety, and this was the guiding factor in the decision. The safety of our community and all the runners has always been the number one priority, and even though we are devastated by the decision, we feel unanimously it is the right choice to make.

As avid runners ourselves, we deeply recognize how frustrating it is that races and events keep getting canceled and we are all feeling the exhaustion of COVID's negative effect at every turn.
